

Golf Cart Accident Guide (keep this in your cart)

WAYS TO STAY SAFE AND PREVENT AN ACCIDENT:

Follow all traffic rules! This includes speed limits, stop signs, and staying on designated paths. Avoid rough terrain, steep inclines and areas not meant for carts.

Buckle up! Always use available seat belts to reduce the risk of injury in case of an accident.

Yield to pedestrians! Give the right of way to pedestrians and be mindful of walkers, especially in busy areas or near clubhouses.

Drive sober! Never operate a golf cart under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Florida's DUI laws apply to golf carts and low speed vehicles!
